Planting for bees

Plant to help bees all season long.

Native Plants

Research-based- plants to support bees all seasons.

Globe Gilia, Douglas Aster, Farewell to Spring, California Poppy (nectar), Oregon Sunshine, Rose Checkermallow, Canada Goldenrod, Phacelia, Yarrow, Pearly Everlasting, Western Columbine

Plants that help Spring Bees

Add some of these: Anemone, Crocus, heather, hellebore, snowdrop, witch hazel, farewell-to-spring, candytuft, sweet box, pieris, early willows, winter daphne, big leaf maple, tall, dwarf or trailing Oregon grape, primrose, California poppy, vine maple, ninebark, crab apple, farewell to spring, catmint, and more. Other good choices: Yarrow, Oregon Sunshine, native sunflowers (Autumn Beauty, Lemon Queen, Black Russian), Canada Goldenrod, Douglas Aster, CA lilac (Ceanothus), Willows, Tickseed (Coreopsis), Lupines, Salvias, Zinnias and Stonecrop(sedums).

Deer resistant plants to consider:

Vine maple, willows, Oregon grape, elderberry, viburnum, yarrow, hyssop, columbine, coreopsis, Delphinium, bleeding heart, foxglove, purple coneflower, hellebore, deadnettle, lavender, lupine, catmint (not catnip), oregano, penstemon, black-eyed Susan, sages, goldenrod, thymes.

Plants: Sleep the first year. Creep the second year. Leap the third year.
